

## **Goffstown Cemetery Trustee Meeting**

**February 11, 2026**

The cemetery trustees held a meeting on Wednesday February 11, 2026 @1 p.m. with Linda Reynolds-Naughton, Valerie Neal, Jean Walker, Jason Georgantas, and Deb Grant were present. There were no public guests.

November 20, 2025, meeting minutes were reviewed, and no corrections were needed. Jean made a motion to accept the meeting minutes for November 20, 2025, Linda seconded the motion and voted in the affirmative 3-0.

Edward and Robin Monty submitted a request for a lot exchange at Shirley Hill Cemetery. They currently own a 21' x 10' lot in Section 3, which was purchased on February 24, 2020, for \$3,000. The lot is vacant and has no headstone. The original deed was provided and verified.

The Monty's requested to exchange their current lot for lots in Section 3 measuring 14' x 20', specifically Lots 86-A, 86-B, 87-A, 87-B, 88-A, 88-B, 89-A, and 89-B. The total cost of the new lots is \$4,000. After applying the \$3,000 from the original purchase, the remaining \$1,000 balance was paid in full.

Valerie made a motion to approve the lot exchange, and Jean seconded the motion. The motion passed in the affirmative, 3-0.

A cemetery maintenance report was provided. Since December 2025 to the present date, 10 lots have been sold at Shirley Hill Cemetery, and one lot has been sold at Westlawn Cemetery.

The Goffstown Rotary Club requested permission to use Parson's Field on June 6 for their annual car show. Set-up will take place on Friday, June 5, with the event running from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. on June 6. Jean made a motion to approve the use of Parson's Field. Jean seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously, 3-0.

Linda made a request for a copy of the Cemetery budget from Adam Jacobs.

Linda inquired about the total number of lots added in the new section at Shirley Hill Cemetery and in the Westlawn expansion. Jason stated that he did not have the exact figures available at the time but would obtain the information and provide it at a later date.

Valerie made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Jean seconded the motion.

Meeting adjourned at 1:20 p.m.
