2) Old Business

Montelona Rd- Stop sign at the intersection of East Dunbarton and Grady Hill

Adam Jacobs motioned NO ACTION for the stop sign installed at East Dunbarton/Montelona Rd.

3) New Business-

Non-Profit Community Center 530 Mast Rd

The Planning Board has asked the Highway Safety Committee to discuss possible parking restrictions on Preston Street due to neighbors' complaints for when the Community Center opens.

The Community Center will be busing kids over from Manchester. Hours of operation will be in the afternoon until 8:30 PM and on the weekends.

The Highway Safety Committee discussed the parking impacts on Preston St and Marion St.

Don Ball motioned to Install NO PARKING SIGNS per the state law requiring 30' separation from an intersection. Costs will be paid by the developer.

Peter Georgantas seconded.

Discussion that there is also a fire hydrant nearby on Preston St which may extend the no parking area.

Motion passes 5-0-0

5 mile per hour speed limit in Goffstown neighborhoods

Peter Georgantas motioned NO ACTION to change speed limits in neighborhoods.

Don Ball seconded.

Discussion that state law that does not allow setting a speed limit this low.
