1) Minutes Approval.

Eric Sereno made a motion to approve June 11, 2025, minutes, as electronically distributed.

Tibbetts Hill Rd

Requesting signage or lighting for curve

Goffstown Police Department ran a data report and found that from 1/1/2020 to 9/2/2025 there were a total of 24 accidents on Tibbetts Hill Road. DPW Director Adam Jacobs also ran a Ball bank check and found that the road did meet the criteria for an advisory speed sign.

The committee reviewed the data. Claire stated that her brother was walking to the mailbox and was almost hit by a driver who was speeding and ended up taking her mailbox out. Claire stated that she has replaced her mailbox numerous times and believes there is some type of BMW racing

group that uses Tibbetts Hill Road as a drag way. Claire is requesting a dangerous curve sign be installed before her mailbox and coming in the other direction.

Adam Jacobs advised that signage for curves has a hierarchy depending on the severity of the curve, the number of accidents, and the speed limit of the road. Adam recommended that he and Chief Sereno reach out to USPS and see if they can get the mailbox moved to the other side of the road closer to the house.

Mark Lemay motioned to recommend a signage package with curve ahead signs coming down and going up Tibbetts Hill Road.

JoAnn Duffy seconded.

Adam Jacobs brought up to discuss that the winding road warning signs are symbols shaped like an S. There is no signage for DANGEROUS CURVE.
