



Goffstown Rail Trail a public park 5.5 miles long

Henry Bridge Road	2.4
Mast Rd traffic lights	2.6
Shell Gas Station	3.5
Mast Rd traffic & trail parking	4.0
Park & Recreation Building	4.5
Village End: Piscataquog River	5.5

The traffic lights along Mast Road are "Pedestrian Hybrid Beacons". This style stays SOLID RED for 7 seconds (persons should start to cross) and then FLASHING RED for 15 seconds (persons finish crossing). During flashing red, drivers may proceed if their lane is clear.
