




Photo Album

Capture cherished holiday memories in a DIY photo album




Supplies Included:

1. Colored cardstock (2)
2. White cardstock (8.5)
3. Cord
4. Nail

Supplies Needed:

1. Hammer
2. Gluestick or tape
3. Pencil
4. Pen (optional)



Instructions

1. Align all 10 full pieces of cardstock, using the colored pieces as the front and back cover.
2. On the front cover, use your pencil to make a mark about 1 inch down from the top and 3/4 inch in from the left side. Do the same an inch up from the bottom (Fig. 1).
3. Use your hammer to drive the nail through each of those marks, making sure to go through all 10 pieces (Fig. 2)
4. Starting from the back cover, thread first one end the cord then the other through the holes you've made (Fig. 3). You may find it easiest to wiggle the nail to enlarge the holes and/or thread the cord through each page individually. Then tie the loose ends together in a bow.
5. Use the remaining half sheet of cardstock to create a label for the cover of your album.
6. Glue or tape in your favorite photos or keepsakes!
