



# Washi Tape Bookmarks

Teen-To-Go


Gather your supplies. You should have two rolls of washi tape, two small pieces of cardstock, two large pieces of cardstock, and four magnets. You may also need scissors.

Make sure the tape is little longer and a little wider than the paper so it can wrap around the edges. If needed, use scissors to even off the tape.

Use more washi tape to cover the back of the bookmark.

Fold the bookmark in half and use it to keep your place in your book! Repeat the steps to make another bookmark with the second small piece of cardstock and magnets.

Begin with one of the short pieces of cardstock. Add strips of washi tape to one side in whatever pattern you like.

Fold the edges of the tape over to partially cover the back side of the bookmark.



Place your magnets on either end of the back of the bookmark.

Use the large pieces of cardstock to make regular bookmarks. You should have enough washi tape to make creative designs.
