

Autumn Fox Coffee Sleeves

Supplies Included:

1. Colored felt
2. White felt
3. Black felt
4. Plaid flannel
5. 1 button

Supplies Needed:

1. Glue: Most kinds of glue will work, but if using regular school glue, make sure to use a little at a time to avoid it seeping through the fabric
2. Permanent marker
3. Paper cup, or any cup with a similar shape



Instructions

1. Cut out the paper templates included on page 5 of these instructions. Use them to cut out the shapes on the fabrics indicated on the template page. You should have:

- 1 coffee sleeve cut out of colored felt
- 1 fox head and body cut out of plaid flannel
- 1 fox tail cut out of plaid flannel
- 2 fox cheeks cut out of white felt
- 1 tail tip cut out of white felt
- 1 nose cut out of black felt (Fig. 1)



Instructions

2. Glue the fox's body to the center of the coffee sleeve. Glue the fox's tail to the bottom of the body piece, as well as where it overlaps onto the coffee sleeve. Glue on the tail tip. Glue the 2 white cheek pieces onto the fox's face, and glue the black nose where they overlap (Fig 2).




3. When the glue has dried, use a marker to draw 2 half circle eyes on the fox's face.




4. Wrap the coffee sleeve around the paper coffee cup and secure the 2 ends with more glue (Fig.3).



5. Where the two ends of the sleeve overlap, glue your button (Fig. 4).



x 2 White Felt






Black Felt
