

Cat Fascinator



Fascinate your cat with a shiny toy!

This asteroid inspired fascinator will intrigue your feline friend for hours.

Asteroid Cat Fascinator

Supplies:

- One (1) plastic stick, dowel, or other handle between twelve and eighteen inches (12"-18") long
- One (1) sheet of tinfoil approximately twenty-four by eighteen inches (24"x18")
- Fifteen (15) strands of curling ribbon at various lengths
- Scissors (optional)

Instructions:

1. Gather one end of each ribbon strand in your hand (**Fig. 1**).
2. Tie a knot in the gathered ends, binding them all together (**Fig. 2**).
3. If desired, use scissors to curl the ribbon by running one blade across the ribbon swiftly (**Fig. 3**).
4. Fold the sheet of tinfoil in half so it measures twelve by eighteen inches (12"x18") (**Fig. 4**).
5. Place one end of the plastic stick and the knot of the ribbon bundle in the center of the tinfoil as in **Fig. 5**.
6. Leaving the ribbons trailing, crumple the tinfoil around the knot and plastic stick, forming a ball (**Fig. 6**).
7. If necessary, roll the tin foil on the table to smooth any corners (**Fig. 7**).



Do not leave this fascinator with your cat unattended. Always keep this fascinator out of reach when not supervising play with your cat. Do not let your cat ingest any part of the fascinator. Visit a vet if accidental ingestion occurs.




