

# Heart Garland



**Love is literally in the air!**

Hang your heart up high this Valentine's Day  
with a festive garland.

## Supplies:

- Five (5) lengths of pink/red yarn approximately thirty-six feet (36') long
- One (1) length of white/cream yarn approximately four feet (4') long
- Cardboard
- One (1) heart template
- Tape
- Scissors



## Instructions:

1. Cut out the heart template on the inside of the line (**Fig. 1**)
2. Trace the template onto the cardboard five (5) times (**Fig. 2**). Cut out the traced hearts. Your end result should be five (5) cardboard hearts (**Fig. 3**).
3. Lay the four foot (4') yarn flat on your work surface.
4. Starting at the left hand side of the yarn, tape a cardboard heart approximately every seven inches (7"), as shown in **Fig. 4**. Tape the yarn as high as possible on the heart. Adjust the hearts as necessary until positioned as desired.
5. Tape one (1) end of a red/pink length of yarn to a cardboard heart (**Fig. 5**).
6. Begin winding the red/pink yarn around the cardboard heart (**Fig. 6**).
7. Wind until only several inches of yarn remain. Tie the remaining red/pink yarn to the white/cream yarn (**Fig. 7**). Trim excess and tuck any tail under the wrapped yarn.
8. Repeat steps five (5) through seven (7) with the remaining cardboard hearts.


