

Red Rock Bracelet



Down to earth never looked so good!

Inspired by the majesty of the American West's iconic red sandstone, this bracelet is sure to stun.

Supplies:

- One (1) clasp
- Approximately ninety (90) imitation red rock beads, various sizes
- Three (3) lengths of fishing line, one foot (1") long
- Scissors


Instructions:

1. Tie the fishing line to one half (1/2) of the clasp with a fisherman's knot as depicted in **Figure 1**. When tightening a fisherman's knot pull on both ends of the fishing line at once.
2. Repeat step one (1) with the other lengths of fishing line. Trim off the short tails of fishing line close to the knot.
3. Thread approximately thirty (30) beads onto one (1) strand of fishing line. Actual amount of beads will vary depending on the desired length of the bracelet. (**Fig. 2 & 3**).
4. When bracelet is the desired length, tie the fishing line to the other half of the clasp with a fisherman's knot (**Fig. 4**).
5. Thread the remaining fishing line back through several beads as in **Fig. 5**. Trim away excess
6. Repeat steps three (3) through five (5) with the remaining strands of fishing line and beads (**Fig. 6**).



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


