

Ribbon Candy Ornament



Cute enough to eat!

Add a little sweetness to your holiday season with these ornaments inspired by ribbon candy!

Supplies:

- Approximately twenty-two inches (22") of wire ribbed ribbon
- Approximately six inches (6") of wire
- Ten (10) pony beads
- One (1) jingle bell
- Pliers/wire cutters (optional)


Instructions:

1. Thread the jingle bell about one-half inch (1/2") onto the wire. **(Fig. 1).**
2. Bend the wire and twist several times to secure the bell, using pliers if necessary. **(Fig. 2).**
3. Unfurl the ribbon. At approximately two inch (2") intervals, fold the ribbon on top of itself accordion style, as in **Figure 3**. When finished, the ribbon should look like a zig-zag with nine (9) corners **(Fig. 4).**
4. Push the wire through the center of the first two inch (2") length of ribbon **(Fig. 5).**
5. Thread a pony bead onto the wire **(Fig. 6).**
6. Repeat steps four (4) through five (5) until all the ribbon and beads have been threaded on to the wire.
7. Use the remaining wire, and pliers if necessary, to fashion a small loop. Wrap excess wire around itself, or use wire cutters to remove. **(Fig. 7).**
8. If desired, snip a 'V' into each end of the ribbon to prevent fraying.


