


Upcycled Keychain



Repurposing never looked so good!

Keep your commitment to saving the earth as close as your keys with this snazzy keychain made from upcycled soda pop tabs


Upcycled Soda Tab Keychain

Supplies:

- Eight (8) soda tabs
- One (1) length of ribbon approximately one foot (1') long
- One (1) key ring, any size
- Scissors

Instructions:

1. Fold the ribbon in half. String key ring onto the folded ribbon. Pull the ends of the ribbon through the loop, creating a cow hitch (**Fig. 1**).
2. String soda tabs onto the ribbon following **Fig. 2** and **Fig. 3** as well as the below instructions:
 - A. Thread each ribbon end through one hole in the first soda tab from the underside.
 - B. Place a second tab over the first. To secure this second tab, thread each ribbon end through the top of the second tab, and down into the first tab once again.
 - C. String a third tab onto the ribbon, again from the underside.
 - D. Place a fourth tab over the third. Again, thread each ribbon end through the top of the fourth tab, and down into the third tab.
 - E. Repeat until all tabs are used (**Fig. 4**).
6. Thread the remaining ribbon through the underside of the eighth tab. Your project should look like **Fig. 5**.
7. Barbs in the soda tabs will prevent the ribbon from slipping out during use. Trim the ends on a diagonal to prevent fraying.








