

Winter Hats



Better bundle up out there!

No knitting required for these decorative, half-sized hats.

Supplies:

- One (1) paper towel tube cut to a height of three quarter inch (3/4")
- Thirty-six (36) lengths of yarn cut to one foot (1')
- Scissors

Instructions:

1. Fold one (1) length of yarn in half.
2. Thread the folded yarn into the paper towel tube as in **Fig. 1**.
3. Fold the looped end over the outside of the paper towel tube. Thread the loose ends of yarn through the looped end as shown in **Fig. 2**.
4. Pull tight (**Fig. 3**).
5. Continue until all lengths of yarn have been used, save one (1) (**Fig. 4**).
6. Gather the loose ends of yarn together (**Fig. 5**) and tie tightly with the remaining length of yarn (**Fig. 6**). With the long tails from the knot, tie a loop for easy hanging if desired.
7. Trim the yarn ends to approximately one half inch (1/2") over the tied yarn. Be careful to avoid the tied yarn with the scissors.
