

Shell and Sea Glass Mobile

Supplies Included:

1. "Driftwood" hanger
2. Assorted seashells and sea glass pieces
3. Fishing line
4. Twine

Supplies Needed:

1. Glue: hot glue, crazy glue, or other clear-drying glue works best
2. Scissors



Instructions

1. On a flat surface, arrange your shells and sea glass into three columns: 1 column of 3 pieces, with 2 columns of 2 pieces, one on each side. (A tip: placing the largest pieces in the center of your design and the smaller pieces at the sides and bottom will help it to look balanced.) (Fig. 1)
2. Cut your fishing line into 3 pieces. Make sure they match the design you made, but 1 should be about 9 inches long, and the other two about 6 inches long.
3. Leaving about 2 inches at the top of each piece the fishing line, glue your shells and sea glass to the line. (Fig. 2)

4. Take one end of twine and wrap it around one end of the driftwood at least twice. Knot the short end to the main strand, securing it. Do the same to the other side. (Fig. 3)
5. Glue the three columns to the back of the piece of driftwood. Trim any excess fishing line. (Fig. 4)
