



# MACRAMÉ PLANT HANGERS



## Supplies Included:

1. Macramé cord: 8 36" pieces, 1 short piece
2. Plant pot
3. Metal ring

## Supplies Needed:

1. A hook to hang your project on while you work
2. Optional: soil and a small plant



# Instructions



1. Fold your 8 long cords in half. Feed the folded end through your metal ring (Fig. 1) then pull the cut ends around the ring and through the loop made by the folded end. Pull tight. (Fig. 2)



2. Hang your ring on a hook or tape flat to a table to hold your project in place.

3. Separate 4 strands of cord. Measure about 2 inches down from your ring and tie a square knot. For instructions on how to tie a square knot, see the next page, or scan the QR code to watch a video.




# Instructions

## To tie a square knot:


- Your 4 strands are the right cord, the left cord, and the 2 middle anchor cords. Bring the right cord over and to the left of the two anchor cords.



- Place the left cord over the right cord.
- Bring the left cord under the anchors and through the loop formed by the right cord.
- Pull and you have the first half of the square knot.



- Bring the left cord over and to the right of the two anchor cords and place the right cord over it.



- Bring the right cord under the anchors and through the loop formed by the left cord.
- Pull the cords and you have the finished square knot.



# Instructions



3. Repeat step #2 3 more times, creating 4 arms (Fig. 3)
4. On one of the arms, measure down from the knot about 3 inches, then tie a square knot connecting two arms. Repeat that step for all the arms (four times total). (Fig. 4)
5. Measure down an inch and connect the arms again with another square knot. Repeat three more times until all the arms are connected the same way.

6. Gather the ends of the cord at the bottom of your hanger and use the 1 short piece of cord to tie them with a wrapping knot. Your hanger is ready for its pot!

## To tie a wrapping knot:

- Form a U shape with one end of your short cord and lay it against the bundled cord.
- Wrap the long end of the cord tightly around the bundle, on top of the U-shaped yarn, leaving the short end and the bottom of the U uncovered.
- Feed that long end through the loop made by the bottom of the U-shape.
- Pull both ends of the cord tight, then trim them to size.
