

# Teen Fabric Wall



## Organizer **Teen-To-Go**



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**Step 1:** Gather your supplies: 4 inch embroidery hoop, two fabric pieces measuring 9 in by 7 in. You may also need scissors and optional, hot glue.

**Step 2:** Loosen the nut on the top of the main embroidery hoop and separate the inside hoop from the outside hoop. Decide which fabric will be the background color and which will be the pocket.

**Step 3:** Place the fabric that will be the background over the inside hoop. Next, fold the other fabric in half lengthwise. Smooth that over the first fabric a little more than halfway down (feel for the hoop underneath to help guide you).

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**Step 4:** Place the outside (main) hoop piece over the fabric, smoothing out any wrinkles and tighten the nut just a bit. Once it's on, you can adjust the second fabric (if it needs straightening). If you want to hold heavy, thick items in the pocket, leave that fabric a bit loose. For smaller items, the pocket can be tighter. Finally, tighten the nut just enough to keep the fabric secure to your liking.

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**Step 5:** Take your scissors and trim off the excess fabric. You can choose to use a hot glue gun to secure the fabric to the back (to either the fabric or hoop). It depends on what you are planning on putting in the pocket! If it's heavier, don't cut off too much fabric, and secure the rest with the hot glue.



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
