



Foam Dice Bunny

Teen-To-Go



Gather your supplies. You should have 2 balloons, a foam die, two squares of felt in white and pink, sheet of glue dots, yarn, 2 toothpicks, colored raffia, a button, cardboard template, and fabric glue. You will also need sharp scissors, a marker, and Qtip.

Cut a pair of ears out of the white felt. Leave a small bit of felt to use for the nose later. Cut a smaller set of ears out of the pink felt. Place a toothpick on the white felt, cover with glue (leave a bit of the toothpick exposed), and press on the pink felt. Do this for each ear, and allow it to dry.

Cut the round lip off the end of each balloon. Stretch the opening several times before moving onto the next step.

Stretch the opening of the balloon to fit over the foam die. This is tough and it may take several tries, but it will fit. Once fitted, trim off neck of the balloon. Repeat with the second balloon. This ensures the dots from the die can not be seen through the balloon.

Using a marker, draw a face on one side of the die. Cut out a triangle nose from a corner of the white felt and attach with the glue dots.

Cut out the circles on the cardboard template. Make a hole in the center of one cardboard circle.

7



Cut off a six inch piece of yarn. Wrap the remaining yard around your fingers. Feed the six inch piece of yarn down between your two inner fingers so that a tail is on each side of the yarn bundle.

Use the tails to tie a knot in the middle of the yarn. Try to keep each yarn side on your fingers, as you pull tight to tie the knot. You may want to wrap the middle several times tightly before knotting.

Cut through the loops on each side of the yarn. This is going to be your pom-pom tail.

10



Feed the tails from the yarn bundle through the hole in the cardboard. Place the other cardboard circle on top of the yarn. Spread out the yarn pieces.

Cut off the yarn that hangs out of the cardboard circles. This will help make your pom-pom uniform.

12



Discard the cardboard circles. Fluff your pom-pom and attach to the back of the foam die with glue dots.

When the ears are dry press the exposed part of the toothpick into the top of the foam die.

Using glue dots, add the finishing touches such as a raffia bow and button.
