

Teen Camera Shaped Journal



Teen-To-Go



1

Gather your supplies. You should have a camera template, 12 pieces of cardstock, 2 loose leaf rings, a piece of ribbon (14in), glitter, 1 sheet of scrapbooking stickers. You will also need scissors, a pencil, glue stick, and hole punch.

Trace the outside outline of the camera onto each piece of cardstock. Then cut out the camera image on each cardstock piece.

Cut out inner lens circle. Use a glue stick to apply glue around the black camera lens (circle). Add glitter on top of the glue all around the circle.

Stack the camera template (this is your cover) and the cut cardstock pieces. Gather a few pages at a time and use a hole punch to make two holes. Use one of the punched sheets as a guide and continue until all sheets are hole punched.

Feed the two loose leaf rings through the holes and secure. Feed the ribbon through the rings and tie the ribbon ends to each other.

Add a picture to the first page. This should peek through the camera lens. Continue to add pictures, stickers, and text to the pages to document your meaningful moments in life.



Note: I used a black marker to color the camera template in the picture at the top. Any color can be used to make it unique.
