Indoor Snowballs



Supplies needed:

- Fluffy white yarn
- Piece of cardboard (about 3x5)
- 3 pieces of yarn about 8in. in length
- Scissors

Directions:


Step 1: Cut a notch in the piece of cardboard.

- Cut a notch in your cardboard piece that is 3 inches deep and 1 inch wide.




Step 2: Wrap the yarn.

- Wrap the yarn over the notched end of the cardboard piece.
- Wrap the yarn about 50-60 times to make a fluffy snowball.



Step 3: Tie the yarn.

- Grab one of the 8in. pieces of yarn.
- Using the notched area of the cardboard, wrap the yarn around the center of the bunched yarn a few times. This should produce an hour glass shape to the yarn bunch.
- Tie the yarn piece into a tight knot. **Please note: in the picture the yarn was not wrapped 40 times to show the tie better. Your yarn bunch will be larger.**



Step 4: Remove the cardboard & shape into a snowball.

- Once tied, remove the looped yarn from the cardboard.
- Cut through the looped yarn on both ends. This produces a rough pom pom shape.
- Trim the ends to produce a nice snowball shape, then fluff.
- Repeat the steps again to make another snowball. And then...
