



Glowing Potion Bottles

Supplies provided:

- pack of water beads
- glass potion jar
- craft plunger
- submersible tealight
- twine & tag



Supplies needed from home:

- a bowl
- 1 cup of water
- strainer or colander

Directions:

1. Pour the water into the bowl and add the pack of water beads.


IMPORTANT: the beads must soak for 6 hours to grow in size.

2. After the beads have grown, use a strainer to remove any remaining water.

3. Place beads (roughly four at a time) into the craft plunger. Press down and smooch the beads into the potion jar. This part is messy!



4. Twist open the tealight. Remove the paper disc protecting the batteries. Twist the tealight back together. The light-bulb should now be lit.



5. Place the tealight light-bulb side down into the jar. Push it down so the smooshed beads fill around it.



6. Place the cork stopper onto the potion jar to seal the top. Write a name for the potion you made on the tag and attach it to the jar with the twine.

7. Turn out the lights and watch your potion jar glow.

TIP: to turn off your light, just remove the tealight and twist until the light-bulb turns off.
